Sir.

In terms of the provisions contained in the Bengal Medical Act, 1914 (as amended), this Council has issued Charge-sheet to you vide No. 0270 − C / 18 − 2021 of 17_04_2025 in connection with the complaint lodged by Sri Golok Sarkar concerning treatment of his daughter, Baby Isha Sarkar and her resultant death, which had duly been replied by you vide your letter dated 05_06_2025. The same was taken into consideration by the Council through the President, WBMC.

The Council considered the case in their Extra-ordinary Meeting held on 04_07_2025 when the Council heard the complainant in your presence and you were then invited to state your case, which you did in presence of the complainant. You had also replied to questions put forward by the Members of the Council through the Chairman of the meeting. You were also provided with the opportunity to cross-examine the complainant, which you did not avail of.

On completion of the hearing, the Chairman called upon the Members present to vote on the question whether Dr. Sunithkumar Ray, Registration No. 37906 of WBMC was guilty of infamous conduct in a professional respect. The Council unanimously decided that the charges brought against Dr. Sunithkumar Ray, Registration No. 37906 of WBMC have been substantiated. In so far as the quantum of punishment, the Council unanimously decided the name of Dr. Sunithkumar Ray, Registration No. 37906 of WBMC be removed from the register of registered medical practitioner for a period of 1 year from the date of communication of order in this respect under Section 25(a) (ii) of the Bengal Medical Act, 1914.

You are hereby advised to submit your Original Final Registration Certificate immediately on receipt of this letter.

Your attention is being drawn to the provision under Section 26 of the Bengal Medical Act, 1914 which reads as under :

Section 26 of the Bengal Medical Act, 1914:

Appeal to the Local Government from decision of Council:

- 26 (1): An Appeal shall lie to the Local Government from every decision of the Council under section 17 or section 25.
- 26 (2): Every appeal under the Sub section (1) shall be preferred within 3 months from the date of such decision.
